# FAQ's:

# Do we provide electricity and Wifi?

Yes, we provide both. There is no fee.

# Can other artisans besides fiber people exhibit?

Absolutely. In 2024 we had an Irish store, a potter, and many other diverse artisans attend.

# Are there places to stay close to the event?

Yes. We highly recommend EC Reeds Mercantile and Hotel. However, they do tend to fill up early – so reserve your spot early. Also, there is a new 'Tree Top' Air BnB which has opened in addition to several other Air BnB locations in Marble Hill. The closest city with hotels is Jackson (closest) and a little further is Cape Girardeau Missouri. Both are a little over 40 minutes away. If you like camping, Bark's Plantation is literally 'over the ridge' from our ranch (in fact, it adjoins our ranch – we just don't have a road to it!). It is about 3 miles away (5 minutes).

# How do I check in when I arrive?

We have a very talented individual, Mila Ballew, who coordinates exhibitors, sponsors, and the volunteers. She is your first point of contact and you will love working with her!

# As a sponsor do I have to have a booth?

No, you do not. You can just enjoy the benefits of our marketing efforts with your branding – no problem. If you do have information that you want to hand out, and you don't want to man the booth, we will have an information table where you can leave your information and attendees can pick it up.

# Are there any special events for vendors?

We do have a thank you dinner for vendors and sponsors on Friday evening after the event closes (at 6 PM). There is no cost to attend, we just want to say thank you for attending the event.

# Can I camp at the event?

Yes, we have a limited number of primitive and trailer camping spots available for sponsors and exhibitors which are free of charge. We do ask attendees to pay a \$25 per night camping fee for camper and primitive camping.
